The AquaMED Dry Hydrotherapy bed is everything I'm not and everything plus.

The AquaMED Dry Hydrotherapy system runs all day long. Not only do I put my patients on, but if they come in with a sibling, friend or parent, I put them on the bed too. This ensures that no one waits idly in the waiting room and really helps with office flow. It is also an opportunity to gain another patient as they only have to try it once before they fall in love with it! It is a great source of income for my practice now and in the future.

This system is for people with pain. I am able to localize the treatment to specific areas and adjust the speed, temperature and pressure for each individual patient. I use the bed for treating anything from fibromyalgia to muscular skeletal pain. I also use it as a "feel good" treatment for those who just want a good massage.

Before the AquaMED, I always had to turn pregnant woman away. The AquaMED gives me an alternative to "no" when pregnant women need relief. They also return after they give birth to continue with their treatments on the bed and sometimes add on other treatments available at my practice.

AquaMED is a great adjunct for people who don't want to take their clothes off and who don't want to be touched by another individual. It is also great for the elderly. It helps them relax and they are ultimately easier to adjust.
